



BMW Club Race School Participant

"Honestly, this looked about like an HPDE 1 group out there!"

This, paraphrased, was the feedback of one of the instructors after the first session of the Bimmerworld BMW Club Racing School at Buttonwillow Raceway. HPDE 1 is what NASA (no, not the space one, the National Auto Sport Association) calls their beginner HPDE group. That's how bad session one of many in this weekend-long racing school went. Oh boy–this is going to be a looooong weekend...

I've made the three and a half hour drive from the Bay Area to Buttonwillow in my mostly track focused E46 M3 mainly to reconnect with my old "Autocross Family" and the many great members of the San Diego BMW Club. I did not know what to expect from either the track, nor the school itself. What a pleasure it was then, when in the very first session out on track I found myself chased down the track by a relentless E36. Oh look! It's Neil from Oceanside Motorsports! Neil was one of the many great instructors for the day that accompanied the 25+ students of the club racing school through a comprehensive program of eight on-track sessions and continuous class instructions in-between. Head instructors Steven Stepanian and Shaun Patrick McKenzie shared a great deal of information and a wealth of knowledge and experience in an effort to prepare the next wave of drivers to be ready to eventually enter the world of club racing.

Over two days the school was just a blur of activities. Great on-track sessions covering everything from going three wide around the race track, to practice starts, a full race simulation and emergency procedures. Equally great off-track sessions followed, where the instructors gave great feedback, set expectations for the next session and shared awesome stories from their racing endeavors.

It was when I came back to my car on Sunday to find my power steering fluid pooled on the ground under my car that I learned maybe one of the greatest lessons for the weekend. Now stranded, miles from home with no tools and no way to tow my car, members of the Strom racing team, who's amazing trailer rig I had parked next to, helped me with tools and supplies to get my car in the air. This allowed me to remove the front bumper and help diagnose the problem–a leaking hose. Neil Daly then took time out of his ridiculously busy weekend schedule to fix my car right there on the spot.

The last session of the weekend is ahead. It's the culmination of the program - a simulated race with full pace car start. It's decision time: Nurse the temporarily fixed car home to make the long drive safely, or risk it for the last session to cap off a great weekend with an amazing racing experience? I asked Neil what he would do. He said what a mechanic with integrity and a great instructor would say: "I can't guarantee that this repair will hold. I cannot tell you to race or not." Then he started to walk away as the next session was about to start. While walking away he must have seen me look tortured and defeated, full of oil and power steering fluid stains with bleeding knuckles, and he mumbled, "Me? If this was a race, I'd be out there..."

After I ran an amazing race simulation and made it home safe that night I couldn't help but reflect on all the great information, instruction, great times with old friends and exciting on-track sessions. But it was the camaraderie of a racing team that doesn't even know me and amazing people like Neil, that truly taught me the spirit of club racing.

or one weekend a year, downtown Long Beach's shoreline area transforms into one of the most unique IMSA Weathertech Sportscar races. To celebrate the occasion, the San Diego BMW CCA organized several team meet-and-greets. Our caravan departed Carlsbad early in the morning and arrived shortly before the Pirelli World Challenge practice and qualifying runs.

With more than 40 BMW fanatics in tow, our first stop was meeting with GT Daytona class' Turner Motorsport Racing. We met with Team Principal Will Turner, drivers Jens Klingmann and Bret Curtis, Turner cast and crew, and the #96 M6 GT3 car sporting Turner's standout yellow and blue livery. Turner provided great insight into the performance, handling, air-conditioning (yes!), tires, and power differences between the race and production cars.

Next up was BMW's flagship GT Le Mans class race team, Team Rahal Letterman Lanigan (RLL). Team RLL has won the Long Beach Grand Prix three times. This year, the team's #24 and #25 cars sport the iconic white body with ///M stripes.

The team's driver lineup looks a little different than last year, with two returning drivers and two new European drivers.

Piloting the #24 car are John Edwards, who has raced with Team RLL since a the 2013 season, and Martin Tomczyk, known for his history in European DTM racing, most recently with Team BMW Schnitzer in an M4 DTM.

Bill Auberlen, longtime BMW driver and SoCal local, is driving Team RLL's #25 car. Auberlen won the Long Beach Grand Prix in 2013 and 2015 in the BMW Z4 GTE, and qualified pole position in the M6GTLM in 2016. Joining Auberlen is British GT driver Alexander Sims. Sims is spending his first season racing in the U.S., but has had his share of success elsewhere, including an overall victory in an M6 GT3 at a 24-hour race in Spa-Francorchamps for ROWE Racing.

The team was very accommodating to our group with drivers and crew making themselves available for questions, pictures, and autographs.

We made a quick stop to visit Boris Said, a man who needs no introduction. Said has raced everything from NASCAR and Trans-Am cars, to E36 and E46 M3 GTRs, Callaway Corvettes, rally cars and more. This year, Boris is racing for SunEnergy1 in the GT Daytona class in a Mercedes-AMG GT3 alongside Tristan Vautier.









Going into Saturday's race with a Balance of Performance adjustment in BMW's favor, there were reasons to believe the BMW Team RLL M6 GTLM would fare well.

After a mediocre Friday qualifying, the #25 and #24 cars qualified fifth and seventh, respectively. All of this went out the window come race time. Only six turns into the race a Risi Competizione Ferrari 488 GTE tangled with a Tequila Patrón prototype car, catching a Ford GT and Corvette C7R in the mix. This provided one of Porsche's new mid-engine 911R to move into first, with the BMWs moving up into second and fourth.

After a pit-stop and driver change, Tomczyk took over BMW's #24 car, moving into first place with roughly 30 minutes remaining. With 10 minutes remaining in the race, things were looking up for the #24 car. However, on the back straightaway, Tomczyk suddenly faced electrical issues causing a temporary power loss, dropping him from first to fourth. By the end of the race, Auberlen's and Sims' #25 car finished just off the podium in fourth, while Edwards' and Tomczyk's #24 car finished in seventh.

Meanwhile, in the GT Daytona class, Turner Motorsport Racing's Bret Curtis and Jens Klingmann, piloting the #96 car, faced their share of adversity. The team made an impressive climb from a fourteenth starting position up to fifth place in class. However, with one corner to go, an overzealous and downright amateur move from a Lexus RC F GT3 slammed into an Acura NSX GT3, which ricocheted into the Turner car, causing them to DNF. After such a hard-fought and strong race, it was a disappointing finish (or lack thereof).

Thank you to BMW Team Rahal Letterman Lanigan, Turner Motorsport Racing, and Boris Said and SunEnergy1 for their accommodations. Additional thanks to our Chapter President, Nick Owen, who coordinated with the teams.

The club members had a great time and enjoyed seeing familiar faces and meeting new friends participating in our club activity.







Sunday, June 18

It's that time again—our annual Runoff Autocross is happening in the West Lot of Qualcomm on Sunday, June 18! This is our tenth runoff event which honors the memory of Rug Cunningham, founder of Cunningham BMW, now known as BMW of El Cajon.

Eleven drivers will qualify for our 2017 Runoff by winning their car classes. The winner of the Runoff will get his or her name on the perpetual trophy and will receive a personal trophy to display with pride. Our format includes one practice session for all drivers, followed by three timed runs to determine trophies for each class. The first-place winner of each car class earns a runoff position in the afternoon. As all other drivers continue to enjoy fun runs in the afternoon, each runoff contender will drive the same "mystery" car. The driver with the best time will be crowned our 2017 Runoff Champion. Will it be you?

Due to a manufacturer recall, we are not allowing SA 2015 Simpson Voyager 2 helmets at any of our driving events without proof of repair from the manufacturer. Thank you for your understanding. IMPORTANT:

- Only Snell 2010 and 2015 helmets are allowed
- All cars MUST be under a 91 dB noise level and we'll be checking! Over 91 dB = no autocross.
- We do run if it's raining—you'll learn more and your tires will wear less!
- You must be a BMW CCA member to participate.
 Join online at www.bmwcca.org in advance. Bring your
 membership card or print your membership confirmation
 if you have not yet received your membership card.
- We usually fill all the spots prior to the event, so register online early.
- If you choose to register onsite, bring cash or check and arrive by 7:30 am.
- The entry fee of \$65 includes breakfast items, lunch and beverages. Additional lunches for guests can be purchased for \$8 at Registration.

Schedule:

6:30 am - Gates Open

7:00 am – Registration and Tech Inspection Open

8:00 am – Tech Inspection Closes (no inspection = no autocross)

8:20 am – Driver Meeting (mandatory)

9:00 am - Course Opens

The day typically ends between 4 – 4:30 pm.

When you arrive:

- 1. If you registered online, stop at the Gate to show your BMW CCA membership card, sign the waiver, receive your wrist band and receive your Tech Card.
- 2. If you did not register online, you will receive a numbered card at Gate in order of arrival; take it to the Registration table after you go through Tech. **Walk-up spots are not guaranteed.**

- Empty all loose items from your car and fill out the participant portion of the Tech Card. Bring your car and Tech Card to the Tech Line. If you pass Tech, you will receive a tech sticker and a run group sticker.
- 4. Take your Tech Card to Registration. You will receive car numbers to place on your side windows.
- 5. If you don't have a helmet, you can rent one at the Timing Trailer for \$10.

Newcomers:

We've all had a first time and we're all still learning, so relax, have fun and enjoy your time with us. You will have an instructor take you around the course for one lap in your car showing you turn-in points, braking zones and so on. Your instructor will then ride with you for your next three laps helping you learn the course. In your next session, and during the timed runs, you can have an instructor with you or you can go solo if your instructor feels you're ready. These events are what you make them; you can push for good lap times and enjoy the friendly competition or you can have more of a social event where running laps is just another part of a fun-filled day.

Please note our car classifications as shown below. Make sure that your car class is up-to-date in Motorsport Reg and if you have questions, feel free to email us at sd-autocross@sdbmwcca.com.

- LC ALL BMWs through Model Year 1988; E30s through Model Year 1986; all naturally-aspirated 4-cylinder models-Stock or Modified
- NAS ALL naturally-aspirated, non M BMWs not in Legacy Class-Stock, and i3
- NAM ALL naturally-aspirated, non M BMWs not in Legacy Class-Modified
- **TS** ALL turbocharged BMWs (4-6-8-12 cyl, gas or diesel)-Stock
- TM ALL turbocharged BMWs (4-6-8-12 cyl, gas or diesel)-Modified
- MS ALL M cars under 400 factory hp-Stock
- MM ALL M cars under 400 factory hp-Modified
- MPS ALL M cars over 400 factory hp-Stock
- MPM ALL M cars over 400 factory hp-Modified
- MC ALL R-class MINI Cooper models (Stock or Modified)
- X ALL non-BMWs, or Austin Mini models
- G ALL Instructors OR experienced drivers who choose Gold Class AND drivers running non-DOT tires (i.e. slicks)
- * Classification for specific cars is at the discretion of the Autocross Director

ONLY Alterations Permitted in Stock Classes:

- ANY size wheel and tires. Tires must have DOT treadwear rating of 140 or higher
- ANY shock absorber using stock mounting and ANY suspension bushing material
- ANY air filter or air intake AHEAD OF mass airflow meter
- Non-stock software/firmware is permitted on naturallyaspirated engines only
- ANY brake pad material is allowed with Stock-size brake components
- Catalyst-back exhaust systems and strut tower braces are permitted

ANY other alterations move to Modified Classes, including:

- Tires with DOT treadwear rating under 140
- Non-stock springs, coilover suspensions, non-stock antiroll bars
- Software/firmware alterations to turbocharged/ supercharged engines
- Non-stock mass airflow meters, camshafts, downpipes, removed catalytic converter
- Non-stock-size brake rotors or calipers (stock-size replacements OK in Stock)

Women drivers and Novices are classified based upon the car they are driving. We award a Women's Class trophy to the woman with the fastest time, and two Novice trophies to the two fastest novices. This means women and novices will be eligible for multiple trophies. You are only a novice for the first and second time you autocross, and if you win a novice or class trophy you are no longer a novice.


