

Remember the sound limit at Qualcomm: all cars must be under a 92db noise level – we'll be checking!

Our sincerest thanks to BMW of El Cajon for their continued support of our Autocross Program!

Newcomers: We've all had a first time and we're all still learning, so relax, have fun and enjoy your time with us. You will have an instructor take you around the course for one lap in your car showing you turn-in points, braking zones and so on. Your instructor will then ride with you for your next three laps helping you learn the course. In your next session, and the timed runs, you can have an instructor with you as much or as little as you want—whatever makes you comfortable. These events are what you make them; you can push for good lap times and enjoy the friendly competition or you can have more of a social event where

running laps is just another part of a fun-filled day.

See the **Autocross Information Page** at http://www.sdbmwcca.com/autocross to get a better idea of how to prepare for this wonderfully addictive sport for your first time.

Note: We do run if it's raining—you'll learn more and your tires will wear less—so if you see some unusual drops of water falling from the sky, grab your raingear and head to the Q! Also, the helmet standard has changed to require Snell 2005 or 2010 ratings. Check yours now to be sure it's up to date—rentals are limited.

The entry fee is \$65, including breakfast items, lunch and beverages. You can pay online if you register in advance at http://sdbmwcca.motorsportreg.com, or with cash or check if you wait to register onsite. You must be a BMW CCA member to participate, and you can join online at www.bmwcca. org in advance. Please **print and bring your membership confirmation** if you have not yet received your BMW CCA membership card. We check membership of all participants at the gate.

REMEMBER: IF REGISTERED ONLINE, **BRING PROOF OF MEMBERSHIP** AND ARRIVE BY 7:30 (BEFORE ON-SITE CUT-OFF) TO KEEP YOUR RESERVED SPOT

Gates will open at 6:30am; tech and registration will open at 7:00am. Tech will close at 8:20am and no cars will be inspected or allowed to run after this time. There is a

mandatory drivers meeting at 8:30am and the course opens for runs at 9:00am.

When you arrive:

- 1. If you registered online, stop at the gate to sign the waiver and notify the Gate Greeter. Your name will be checked off the pre-registration list. All participants must show their BMW CCA membership card. Those who did not register online will receive a numbered card at the gate in their order of arrival; take it to the Registration table. There is no guarantee that spots will be available for those who wait to register the day of the event.
- 2. Empty all loose items from your car, then go through the Tech Line and have your car inspected. Bring your Tech card and you will receive Tech and helmet stickers.
- 3. Take Gate card and Tech card to Registration to get checked off for pre-registration or pay your \$65 entry fee. You will receive car numbers to place on your side windows.
- 4. If you don't have a helmet, you can rent one from the club for \$10.
- 5. Your entry fee of \$65.00 includes one lunch and unlimited beverages. Additional lunches can be purchased at Registration for \$7 each.

Women drivers and Novices are classified based upon the car they are driving. We award a Women's Class trophy to the woman with the fastest time, and two Novice trophies to the two fastest novices. This means women and novices will be eligible for multiple trophies. You are only a novice for the first and second time you autocross, and if you win a novice or class trophy you are no longer a novice.

New Autocross Classes for 2015 by Dan Tackett

ur Autocross Committee met in November to discuss upgrades and refinements in our popular Autocross program. We won't change our spirit of fun or our welcoming attitude. But the time has come to evolve our car classes, after reviewing past entries and with an eye toward the future. The goal is to still keep it simple and objective, while better balancing the number of drivers in each class. We know that fast drivers usually get fast times, no matter the car, so we didn't want to create too many complicated car classes.

We welcome members driving non-BMWs, and our X Class often makes up 20-40% of our entries. But they will remain in one class, since we are the BMW Club after all. We also won't change the Mini Cooper Class or the definition of Stock vs. Modified cars, since that has been clear and works well. The most popular BMWs are, and will likely remain, the M cars. 3 Series models, particularly E30s, make up most of the rest of our cars, and BMW's all-turbo current model lineup means that we will see even more turbo cars in the future. Here is a description of the classes starting January 2015:

LEGACY CLASS: Replacing our small 4 Cylinder Class, we now add all BMWs up to the 1988 model year and E30s up to the 1986 model year. We want to honor our heritage and show respect to drivers of earlier models, but this (hopefully) brings more cars into this class. The cutoff years keep E28s and E30 325e models in Legacy. We still expect this to be a small (but important) class, so stock and modified are combined.

NATURALLY ASPIRATED: This is the former 6-8-12 cylinder class, removing the earlier 6-cylinder cars and 325e models. There is no horsepower cap since the higher stock hp models tend to be larger/heavier models that aren't as nimble in an autocross.

TURBO CLASS: This class will only grow as members replace their cars with newer models. We combined 4-cylinder and 6 (or more) cylinder turbo cars into the

same group because recent results and published road tests show that the lighter, better balanced N20 cars are very competitive with N54/55 cars. BMW's modern diesels are also very quick, so they fit in this group of cars. The "M Performance" M235i will fall here instead of in M class due to its open differential and softer-than-M-suspension.

M CLASS: With M cars as our core competitors, we decided to add another category and split M cars into two groups (more trophies!) at the 400 factory hp point. So E30-46 M3s and 6 cylinder M5/6s fit here, along with E39 M5s (394 net bhp).

M PLUS CLASS: M cars over 400 hp stock, such as E9X and V10 and turbo M cars.

There may be an individual car now and then that doesn't fit perfectly in our new class definitions (1989 635CSi, 524td, etc.), so the Autocross Director has the final discretion.

We know that we can't please absolutely everyone unless we have 100 different classes and 100 trophies for 100 drivers, but remember, this is all about having fun!

INSTRUCTOR TRAINING SCHOOL by Dan Tackett, Chief Instructor

BMW CCA has a well-developed curriculum for training new Instructors for our Driving School program. Though we are a volunteer organization, we take pride in the quality of our track events and the professionalism of our Instructor Corps. Our Chapter hosted training events for the Pacific Region every other year for a long time, in conjunction with our former school venue at Buttonwillow Raceway. For several reasons, no Chapter in our region has been able to organize an instructor-training event for the last seven years, leading to a shortage of formally trained Instructors. Last year at

Chuckwalla, we just couldn't get enough instructors to reach our ideal ratio, leaving them overworked, and our students sometimes waiting while their instructor was finishing up with someone else. We either needed to reduce the number of



students this year or increase the number of instructors. I think we did the right thing.

Following a lot of planning, last November the national **Driving Events**

Committee flew out five core instructors from Eastern states to guide us through a formal Instructor Training School (ITS) at Willow Springs Raceway. This program has been refined over many years and consists of two rigorous days alternating between classroom time and track time. Each candidate is assigned an experienced instructor as their mentor for twodays of role-playing. Instructors aren't chosen because they are the fastest drivers, though they have to be consistent and quick. Their role involves being a coach, a careful observer, a good listener, offering encouragement where necessary and taking control of certain circumstances.

The classroom PowerPoint covered a wide array of topics, from clear and concise communication techniques to driver psychology, from first-interaction priorities to building a

"toolbox" for an on-track curriculum, from public relations to emergency management. The track sessions had mentors behind the wheel role-playing different student types, which required the candidate to figure out the best way to

handle each situation. We concluded with an evaluation conducted by a different mentor, using a detailed scoring system, and mentor group discussion of the strengths of each of the 21 candidates. After two days of intensive training,


