- We have not yet received the refund from Buttonwillow for our deposit.

- **Regional Call Highlights** The call discussed the push to get lapsed members to renew, and encouragement to plan events that will draw new and returning members. It was announced that Jeff Cowan is stepping down as Pacific Region VP when his current term expires next year. Anyone interested in running for the position needs to have forms submitted by this October.
- **Non-member Revenue** Greg will be scheduling a meeting to discuss non-member revenue with representatives of the National Board.
- **Resuming in-person meetings** The pros and cons of resuming in-person meetings vs. continuing Zoom meetings were discussed. Meeting in person allows attendance by members and getting them involved for possible Board service. Meeting via Zoom allows remote people to attend and saves money and commute time.
